- > SCL is certified by the State of New Jersey as a full-service toxicology laboratory that provides testing services for drugs-of-abuse detections, delivering quality service to its customers.
- > SCL is an approved Medicaid provider in the state of New Jersey along with other insurances.
- > SCL specializes in toxicology for drug monitoring. Our goal is to provide results that help practitioners to make informed decisions quickly and reliably. SCL offers a comprehensive toxicology pain panel.
- > For most drug tests, the initial screen is performed using Enzyme Immunoassay (EIA) methodology. EIA involves a binding reaction between the target drug or drug metabolite and an antibody producing a signal that is detected by automated instruments indicating whether the target compound might be present in the specimen. This technology provides fast, efficient separation of negative specimens from those that require further testing.
- > SCL uses a panel of analytes that is optimized for clinical use to detect a wide range of prescription brand name drugs, illicit drugs, and alcohol in urine. Our results are easy to read and accurate.
- > SCL utilizes state of the art, specific equipment and technology available to screen, confirm and quantitate drugs of abuse.
- > SCL comprehensive testing menus provide a wide selection of tests to meet the needs of various patients, and health care professionals treating pain, substance use disorders and other psychiatric disorders.
- > Confirmatory drug tests for positive specimens are performed with Gas Chromatography – Mass Spectrometry (GC/MS) or Liquid Chromatography – Mass Spectrometry (LC/MS) methodology. These instruments are capable of specifically identifying and distinguishing the drug or drug metabolite from other compounds that might be present in the specimen. At the same time, they can accurately measure the concentration of the target compound.



ROUTINE LABORATORY TESTING SERVICES

SCREENING METHODOLOGY

In order to determine if a specimen is negative or positive for drugs of abuse, all specimens are initially screened by an enzyme immunoassay (EIA) procedure. Specimens that yield an EIA response below the specified cutoff are reported as not detected. Specimens that show an EIA response at or above the specified cutoff are considered “presumptive positive” for a particular drug or drug class. Presumptive positive specimens may be confirmed by a second method prior to reporting positive results.

WHY DRUG TESTING

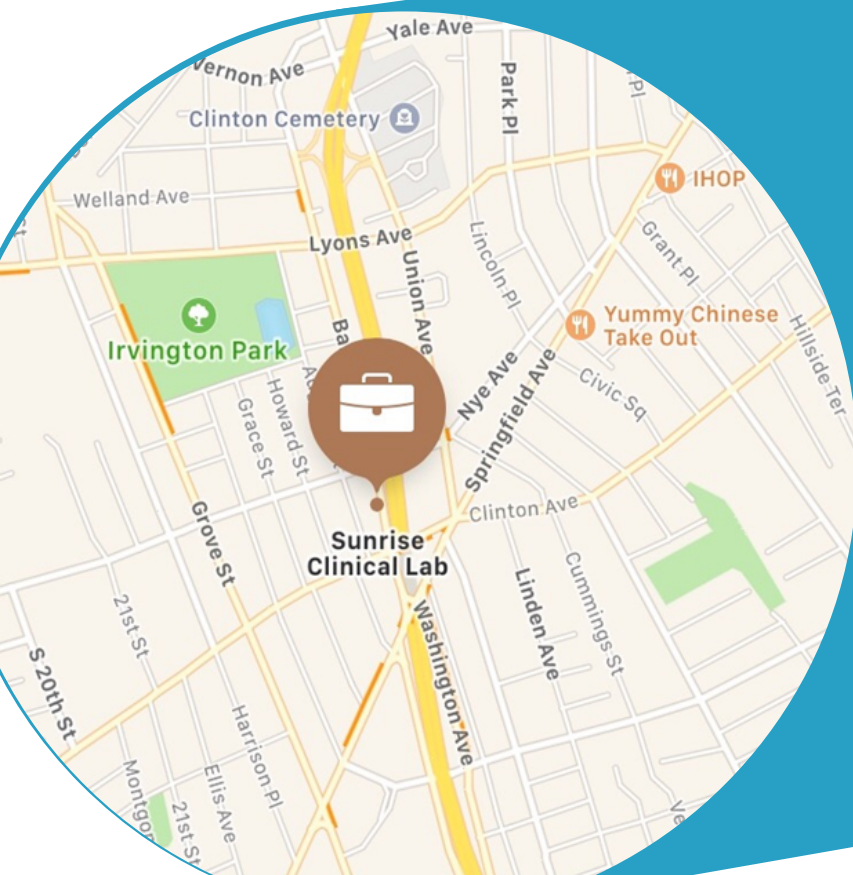
